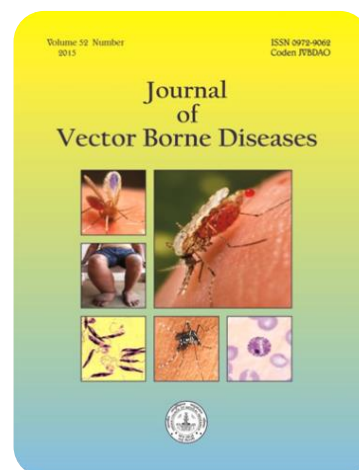

The *Journal of Vector Borne Diseases* is a peer reviewed, open access biomedical journal published by ICMR–National Institute of Malaria Research, New Delhi on behalf of the Indian Council of Medical Research, an autonomous body under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India. It is one of the oldest journals in India, which started its publication It is one of the oldest journals in India, which started its publication long back in the year 1947, as the *Indian Journal of Malariology*, and was later superseded by the *Journal of Vector Borne Diseases* in 2003. In a short period, it achieved significant ranking among the journals in its field. The Journal had an impact factor of 1.190 in 2016 and 0.886 in 2017. It is indexed with, or included in, all the major indexing agencies like MEDLINE (PubMed), Science Citation Index Expanded, Web of Science, Scopus, DOAJ, EMBASE/Excerpta Medica, Indian Science Abstracts, SJR *etc.*

The *Journal of Vector Borne Diseases* intends to publish a special edition on “**Malaria Elimination**” on World Malaria Day, April 25, 2019. Accordingly, the JVBD team invites original and unpublished articles relevant to broader theme of malaria eradication and elimination. The articles can be submitted in the form of a critical review, an article of opinion, original research or a short report *etc.* The last date for submission for such articles is 28 February, 2019. The articles will be peer-reviewed and suitably edited before publication.
